

# Perry Project Commission Application Packet

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Mission Statement: Revitalization of downtown Perry to encourage investment of current and future building and business owners and entrepreneurs with a focus on residential, retail, and restaurants.

The Perry Project Commission was formed in August of 2017 when local citizens wanted to focus on revitalizing downtown Perry, OK. The group decided to partner with Main Street of Perry. This was done not only to share the resources that are available to Main Street; but to attract investors looking to help revitalize Perry and gain a tax incentive by donating through a reputable 501(c) 3 organization.

The Perry Project Commission is offering grant opportunities for current and new business owners and operators seeking assistance monetarily or otherwise. Applicant's intended business must be focused in the area of improving or expanding residential, retail, or restaurant space and must be a business that pays sales tax. Grants may be awarded as requested, as funds and resources are available, or based upon a majority voting by the Perry Project Commission Group.

In order to be considered a qualified applicant all items in the checklist below must be included. In the event that an item is missing, the grant application will be denied and must be resubmitted.

\_\_\_\_\_ Application Form: Form must be fully completed and signed

\_\_\_\_\_ Business Plan: Completed business plan must be submitted with the application

\_\_\_\_\_ Project/Budget Timeline: If not included in your business plan, include a detailed project and budget timeline.

\*\*\* After the necessary forms and application are submitted to the Perry Project Commission, the board will review all submitted applications. In the event there are multiple applicants and decisions must be voted on, you will be contacted. Each applicant will also be subject to an informal interview at the board's discretion.
